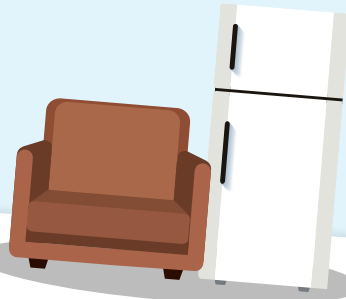


Your bin store recycling collection



Please keep your bin store tidy. No recycling or rubbish should be left on the floor or on top of bins.



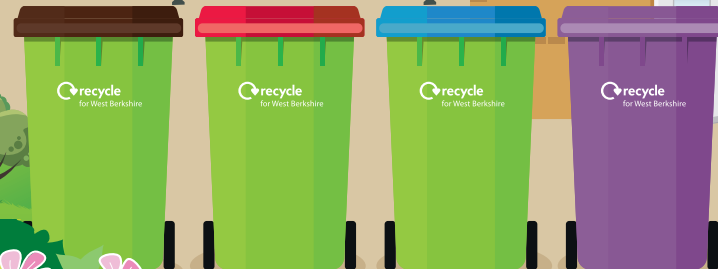
Please do NOT leave furniture or large items of rubbish in your bin store.

Your bin store recycling

This page is a guide to show you what you can put in each recycling bin. The bins are labelled to show which materials can be put into them – please make sure you only put the right materials into each bin for recycling.

Plastic bottles, aerosols, cans and tins only



✓ Aerosols ✓ Drink cans



✓ Food tins ✓ Metal sweet tins



✓ Plastic bottles (please place lids in the bin loose)

As a general rule, if your plastic waste is bottle shaped it can go in the recycling bin.

- ✗ Other plastic packaging
- ✗ Polystyrene
- ✗ Plastic bags and film
- ✗ Aerosol cans with an orange and black cross
- ✗ Plastic trays and tubs

Glass bottles and glass jars only



✓ Glass bottles

Please make sure jars are rinsed through to remove food residue. Lids can be left on.

- ✗ Window and greenhouse glass
- ✗ Broken glass
- ✗ Pyrex and drinking glasses
- ✗ Light bulbs

Paper and cardboard only



✓ Egg boxes ✓ Magazines & newspapers ✓ Envelopes



✓ Catalogues ✓ Cardboard tubes ✓ Junk mail



✓ Cardboard packaging

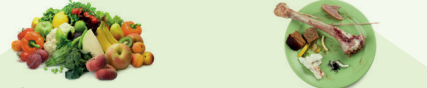
Please make sure you flatten cardboard to no bigger than 85cm x 45cm.

- ✗ Padded envelopes
- ✗ Tetra Paks/juice cartons
- ✗ Shredded paper
- ✗ Tissues
- ✗ Wallpaper

Food waste only



✓ Meat, fish and bones ✓ Tea bags and coffee grounds



✓ Fruit and vegetables ✓ Plate scrapings



✓ Bread and pastries

Please only use compostable liners for your food waste.

- ✗ Animal bedding
- ✗ Garden waste
- ✗ General waste
- ✗ Liquids and fats
