Wise Regulation 19 Objection.

I am objecting in the strongest possible terms to the plan to build on our beautiful countryside to the detriment of the numerous wildlife and the green fields & trees much admired in the area.

Since moving to Upper Bucklebury in 2006 traffic through the village has increased considerably and the majority of the new inhabitants will choose to come through the village in preference to the A4 which will make it extremely difficult to turn out of our drives onto [REDACTED].

New residents will be given preference to Kennet School which is already crowded which will mean that children in Bucklebury will only have access to Downes Sch.

Vast swathes of our countryside have been concreted over. Wild life is increasingly

limited to smaller and smaller areas.
Whilst I appreciate people have to live
somewhere but brownfield sites are under
used and apparently an area in Colthorpe
is being ignored where the developer has even
offered to build a new bridge.

I hope and pray that the numerous
objections will be listened to and taken
into account,

People in Bucklebury and Upper
Bucklebury live where they do as they want
to live in a country village and not part
of Thatcham.

I have been told that the development
will be over a period of twenty years
and whilst its completion will no longer
affect me I am concerned for our countryside
in the future and our younger population
who will still benefit from our fields
