I oppose the inclusion of the Land East of Pincents Lane as a development site as well as the associated proposal to extend the Tilehurst settlement boundary. This site has repeatedly been discounted as a viable site for development due to multiple reasons. It is a valuable local green space which is frequently used by local residents and families. It is also an important area for nature, and work by members of local groups has documented the wide range of birds and mammals who live in and use this habitat. I do not see how developing site like this is consistent with the current work to develop a Local Nature Recovery Strategy. The loss of this green space for residents and wildlife would be to the detriment of the local area.

There are also significant concerns around the suitability of the area for development due to lack of appropriate access routes for ordinary vehicles as well as emergency services, and the existing problems with congestion on Bath Rd which has a serious impact on commuters and travellers on this key transport route out of Reading and which would only be exacerbated by additional development on the Pincents Land site.

I understand the need for more house building but the development of this land would create housing in a marginal and poorly accessible site and would not compensate for the significant negative impact on the local community and wildlife.
