ONR supports the soundness of the overall plan as it relates to its approach towards **not** allocating residential sites in the Detailed Emergency Planning Zone ("DEPZ") of AWE Burghfield ("AWE(B)"). Additionally, ONR supports the modification to SP4 and the supporting text.

ONR currently judges the OSEP for AWE(B)'s DEPZ to be stretched, which poses challenges for accommodating new development in the area covered by the OSEP.
