The West Berkshire District Council (Pangbourne Meadows) Public Spaces Protection Order

West Berkshire District Council ("the Council") makes this Public Spaces Protection Order under section 59 of the Anti-Social Behaviour, Crime and Policing Act 2014 ("the Act").

The Order may be cited as the West Berkshire District Council (Pangbourne Meadows) Public Spaces Protection Order and shall came into force on 19th June 2025 and lasts for a period of 3 years.

The Council is satisfied on reasonable grounds that activities carried out in a public space within the Council's area have had a detrimental effect on the quality of life of those in the locality and the effect of these activities is or is likely to be of a persistent or continuing nature, is or is likely to be such as to make the activities unreasonable and justifies the restrictions imposed by this Order. The activities include persons behaving in a manner that has caused or is likely to cause, nuisance, harassment, alarm or distress.

- This Order relates to Pangbourne Meadows situated north of the settlement of Pangbourne, Berkshire as shown edged in red on the map attached ("the Restricted Area") being land in the area of the Council which is land to which the Anti-Social Behaviour, Crime and Policing Act 2014 applies and will be protected by the making of this Order.
- 2. The Order may be cited as the West Berkshire District Council (Pangbourne Meadows) Public Spaces Protection Order and shall came into force on 19th June 2025 and last for a period of 3 years.
- 3. The effect of the Order is to impose the following prohibitions and/or requirements in the Restricted Area at all times between the months of April and October (inclusive), unless specifically stated:-
 - 3.1 any person behaving in a manner that has caused, or is likely to cause, nuisance, harassment, alarm or distress must leave the Restricted Area when requested to do so by an authorised officer for a specified time and not return to that area for a period not exceeding 24 hours; and
 - 3.2 any person is prohibited from riding or using an E-Bike or E Scooter and must leave the Restricted Area when requested to do so by an authorised officer for a specified time and not return to that area for a period not exceeding 24 hours.
- 4. An authorised officer as referred to in paragraph 3 of this Order, includes a constable, namely a police officer and a police community support officer or a person who has been authorised for this purpose by the Council.
- 5. Any person who fails to comply with the requirement in paragraph 3 of this Order, under section 67 of the Act is liable on summary conviction to a fine not exceeding level 3 on the standard scale or a Fixed Penalty Notice up to a maximum of £100.
- 6. If any interested person desires to question the validity of this Order on the grounds that the Council has no power to make it or that any requirement of this Act has not been complied with in relation to this Order, he or she may apply to the High Court within six weeks from the date on which the Order is made. An interested person is an individual who lives in the specified area or who regularly works or visits that area.


