

**WEST BERKSHIRE DISTRICT COUNCIL
(OXFORD ROAD, DONNINGTON)
(30 M.P.H SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 202***

WEST BERKSHIRE DISTRICT COUNCIL in exercise of powers under Sections 84(1) and (2) and of Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby makes the following order:-

1. This Order shall come into operation on the XXth day of XXXXXX 202* and may be cited as the **WEST BERKSHIRE DISTRICT COUNCIL (OXFORD ROAD, DONNINGTON) (30 M.P.H SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 202***
2. No person shall drive any motor vehicle in any direction at a speed exceeding 30 M.P.H on the length of road specified in the Schedule to this Order
3. Nothing in Article 2 shall apply to any vehicle on an occasion when it is being used for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes, if the observance of that provision would be likely to hinder the use of the vehicle for the purpose of which it is being used on that occasion
4. Nothing in Article 2 shall apply to any vehicle or vehicles falling within regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011 if that vehicle or vehicles is/are being used in accordance with regulation 3(5) of those Regulations
5. The **ROYAL COUNTY OF BERKSHIRE (OXFORD ROAD, DONNINGTON) (SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 1995** is hereby revoked in its entirety.
