## (A339 NEWBURY AND GREENHAM) (50 MPH SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 2007

West Berkshire District Council in exercise of powers contained in Sections 84(1) and (2) and of Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulations Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby makes the following order:-

- 1. This Order shall come into operation on the 30<sup>th</sup> day of March 2007 and may be cited as the WEST BERKSHIRE DISTRICT COUNCIL (A339 NEWBURY AND GREENHAM) (50 M.P.H. SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 2007
- 2. No person shall drive any motor vehicle in any direction at a speed exceeding 50 M.P.H. on the length of road specified in the Schedule to this Order
- Nothing in Article 2 shall apply to any vehicle on an occasion when it is being used for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes, if the observance of that provision would be likely to hinder the use of the vehicle for the purpose for which it is being used on that occasion
- The West Berkshire District Council (A339 Newtown Road and Sandleford Link, Newbury) (50 mph Speed Limit) order 2004 in its entirety
- The A339 Trunk Road (Headley) (40 and 50 miles per hour speed limits) Order 2000 insofar as it relates to the roads specified in the schedule to this Order

## **SCHEDULE**

## IN THE PARISH OF GREENHAM 50 M.P.H SPEED LIMIT

A339 Newtown Road/Sandleford

Between a point on A339 "Sandleford Link" approximately 37 metres south of its junction with the southern kerb line of A343 St Johns Road and a point on A339 approximately 190 metres south east of its junction with Thornford Road a distance of approximately 5810 metres

B4640


Between its junction with A339 and a point on B4640 approximately 62 metres south of the centre of "The Swan" roundabout
