

**WEST BERKSHIRE DISTRICT COUNCIL
(SULHAMSTEAD HILL, SULHAMSTEAD)
(30 M.P.H SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 202***

WEST BERKSHIRE DISTRICT COUNCIL PROPOSES to make an Order under Sections 84(1) and (2) and of Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 the effect of which is to extend the 30mph speed limit from Sulhamstead village northwards to the A4. The exact extents of the total 30mph restriction would be:

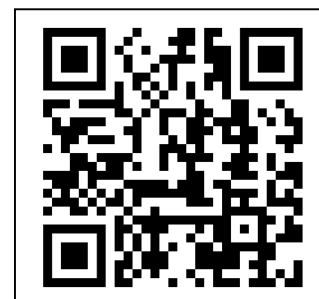

The **ROYAL COUNTY OF BERKSHIRE (RESTRICTED ROADS) (SULHAMSTEAD ROAD/SULHAMSTEAD HILL, SULHAMSTEAD) (NO:4) ORDER 1986** would be revoked in full and with the exception of the changes made by the proposed new order, all other limits referred to in the proposed new order are consolidations of the 1986 order that is to be revoked.

No statutory provision imposing a speed limit on motor vehicles shall apply to any vehicle on an occasion when it is being used for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes, if the observance of that provision would be likely to hinder the use of the vehicle for the purpose for which it is being used on that occasion.

No speed limit imposed by this Order shall apply to vehicles falling within regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011 when used in accordance with regulation 3(5) of those Regulations.
