

**WEST BERKSHIRE DISTRICT COUNCIL  
(A339 & B4640, GREENHAM)  
(VARIOUS SPEED LIMITS) ORDER 202\***

**WEST BERKSHIRE DISTRICT COUNCIL PROPOSES** to make an Order under Sections 84(1) and (2) and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 the effect of which is to reduce the speed limit on the A339 between the Pinchington Lane roundabout and the Swan roundabout from 50mph to 40mph. The proposed order will also reduce the speed limit on the A339/Pinchington Lane roundabout from 50mph to 30mph. The exact extents of these changes are as follows:

**SCHEDULE 1 – 30MPH SPEED LIMIT**

A339/Pinchington Lane roundabout	Entirety of roundabout that connects Monks Lane, Pinchington Lane and A339 and for a distance of 60m south, 75m north, 53m east and 36m west from the center of said roundabout

**SCHEDULE 2 - 40 MPH SPEED LIMIT**

A339 Newtown Road	Between a point approx. 60m south of the centre of its roundabout with Pinchington Lane/Monks Lane and a point approx. 50m northwest of the centre of its roundabout with the B4640 Sandleford (aka Swan roundabout)

**SCHEDULE 3 – 50 MPH SPEED LIMIT**

A339	Between a point approx. 37m south of its junction with the southern kerbline of the A343 St Johns Road and a point approx. 75m north of the center of its roundabout with Monks Lane/Pinchington Lane
A339 Basingstoke Road	Between a point approx. 50m northwest of the center of its roundabout with the B4640 (aka Swan roundabout) to a point approx. 170m southeast of its roundabout with Thornford Road (county boundary)
B4640 Sandleford	Between the center of its roundabout with the A339 Basingstoke Road to a point approx. 72m south (county boundary)

The **WEST BERKSHIRE DISTRICT COUNCIL (A339 NEWBURY AND GREENHAM) (50 MPH SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 2007** would be revoked in its entirety and with exception of the changes made by the proposed new order, all other limits referred to in the proposed new order are consolidations of the 2007 order that is to be revoked.

No statutory provision imposing a speed limit on motor vehicles shall apply to any vehicle on an occasion when it is being used for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes, if the observance of that provision would be likely to hinder the use of the vehicle for the purpose for which it is being used on that occasion.

No speed limit imposed by this Order shall apply to vehicles falling within regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011 when used in accordance with regulation 3(5) of those Regulations.
