NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that WEST BERKSHIRE DISTRICT COUNCIL has MADE the above Order the effect of which will be to further amend the **WEST BERKSHIRE DISTRICT COUNCIL (PROHIBITION AND RESTRICTION OF WAITING AND LOADING, PARKING PLACES AND RESIDENTS' PARKING) (CONSOLIDATION) ORDER 2009 (as amended) ("the Principal Order")** to the extent as set out below but in all other respect the Principal Order remains in force:

PLANS

Schedule 2 of the Principal Order has been amended by the revision of the following plans:
AR72, AS72, AT72, AU72 and AU73

The amendment order signifies a change or addition of parking restrictions at the following locations:

Thatcham

A4 Bath Road –

- (i) (both sides) between the Thatcham Garden Centre entrance and Henwick Lane,
- (ii) (north side) fronting Nos 95-109,
- (iii) (both sides) between the western junction of St Johns Road and Green Lane
Beverley Close, Faircross Court, Northfield Road, St Johns Road and The Firs

The order was made on Tuesday 14th April 2026 and will come into force on Friday 17th April 2026.

If you wish to question the validity of the Order or any provisions contained within it on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act or any instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Order, you may, within six weeks from the 14th April 2026, apply to the High Court for this purpose.
