

WEST BERKSHIRE DISTRICT COUNCIL
(B4009 STREATLEY HILL, B4009 ALDWORTH ROAD & LEWENDON HILL,
STREATLEY) (40 M.P.H SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 202*

WEST BERKSHIRE DISTRICT COUNCIL proposes to make an Order under Sections 84(1) and (2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 the effect of which is to implement a 40mph speed restriction on the B4009 Streatley Hill between its junction with The Coombe (approx.) and 83m west of Lewendon Hill (approx.).

No statutory provision imposing a speed limit on motor vehicles shall apply to any vehicle on an occasion when it is being used for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes, if the observance of that provision would be likely to hinder the use of the vehicle for the purpose for which it is being used on that occasion.

No speed limit imposed by this Order shall apply to vehicles falling within regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011 when used in accordance with regulation 3(5) of those Regulations.
