What data will we collect about you?

When you make an enquiry, we will collect details of:

- your name
- ways to contact you e.g. email address, telephone number or postal address
- the details of your enquiry

Optionally, you may give us your library membership card number, and we'll use this to retrieve up-to-date contact details from your library membership file.

What will we use your data for?

We will use this data to get in touch with you in response to your enquiry. It won't be used for any other reason.

Who will see your data?

Your data will be seen by authorised West Berkshire Council staff involved in responding to your enquiry.

We will not share your information with any third parties.

Why are we doing this?

West Berkshire Council runs a library service for its communities. As part of that service, it provides the means to make enquiries. As such, processing of your data is necessary in the public interest, as part of the statutory service the Council provides in its role as a Public Authority.

How long will your data will be kept?

Your data will not be kept any longer than necessary. You can check how long the organisation will keep each type of data against West Berkshire Council's retention schedule (www.westberks.gov.uk/retention).

How is your data stored and processed?

Your data will be held on the Council's database designed for handling customer enquiries and will be protected using up-to-date technical and organisational security measures.

Transfer overseas

Your data will not be stored or sent outside of the UK.

Your rights

You have a number of rights when it comes to the data we hold about you. These are detailed on our request form (www.westberks.gov.uk/dprequest) that also allows you to make a request for us to take action about something.

Complaints
